THE ELUSIVE RINGTAIL CAT

Closely related to racoons, these nocturnal critters are solitary omnivores, feeding mostly on insects, mice, wood rats, soft fruits, and berries. Ringtails spend much of their time in bushy, wooded areas along water courses, and utilize tree hollows, rock crevices, abandoned burrows and buildings as dens. They are able to rotate their ankles 180 degrees which allows them to descend
