

Eastern Bluebird

(Sialia sialis)

- Eastern Bluebirds live in meadows and various spots that they consider suitable for nesting sites such as old woodpecker holes or nesting boxes
- Bluebirds mostly like to eat insects they catch on the ground and in the winter they like to eat fruits and berries
- They have really good eyesight and can see their small prey from 60 or more feet away!
- Size: Small
- Color: Males are a vivid deep blue with a rusty/brick red belly. Females are gray with bluish wings and tail and they have a lighter orange brown belly
